LOS CARNEROS PINOT NOIR

Los Carneros is Napa's appellation that most resembles Burgundy, France. This Pinot Noir celebrates the refined elegance, vibrancy, and balanced style of a classic Old World Pinot Noir.

STARTING IN THE VINEYARD

2014 was another excellent vintage, despite an ongoing drought and earthquake that rocked south Napa in late August just as crush was getting underway. A mild winter and spring resulted in early budbreak, and moderate temperatures, with only minimal rain in September, allowed for even ripening.

TO THE CELLAR

Eighteen days of skin contact via cold-soak extracted the rich color and fruit flavors. Ten months of French oak aging mellowed the tannins and enriched the structure and mouthfeel, leading to a long, silky finish.

IN YOUR GLASS

A translucent bright ruby color, this wine's aromas redolent of cherry pie and clove with a hint of wet earth that Pinot Noir is notorious for. In the mouth, rich flavors of baked plum tart, pomegranate, and dark cherries shine with bright acidity and soft tannins.

ON YOUR TABLE

The soft richness of our Pinot would be equally great with a lamb tagine or cedar-planked salmon with a cherry cola reduction. If you're throwing a Latin party, pollo asado with all the fixings would be a perfect match!
