STARTING IN THE

VINEYARD

The 2019 growing season started out with copious rainfall. The long, warm summer saw few extreme heat waves, and the foggy mornings set the stage for vibrant and expressive wines. The long mild late summer helped preserve freshness and finesse in the fruit.

> TO THE **CELLAR**

Hand harvested in late September, then gently pressed and racked; this wine aged for 23 months in 70% new French oak barrels.

IN YOUR

GLASS

The wine explodes in the glass with wet clean stone, dark ripe luscious dark cherry, cassis, blackberry, tobacco, rose petals, mocha, dark chocolate, and pumpkin candy. This leads to your palate bursting with intense dark cherry, cranberry, vanilla, and plum. The well-integrated and chewy tannins create a mouthwatering experience that finish long and complex.

A wonderful pairing that would not let you down would be a medium rare Ribeye steak topped with Sauteed Wild Mushrooms and a Red Wine Reduction Sauce.
